Trends in community development and volunteerism

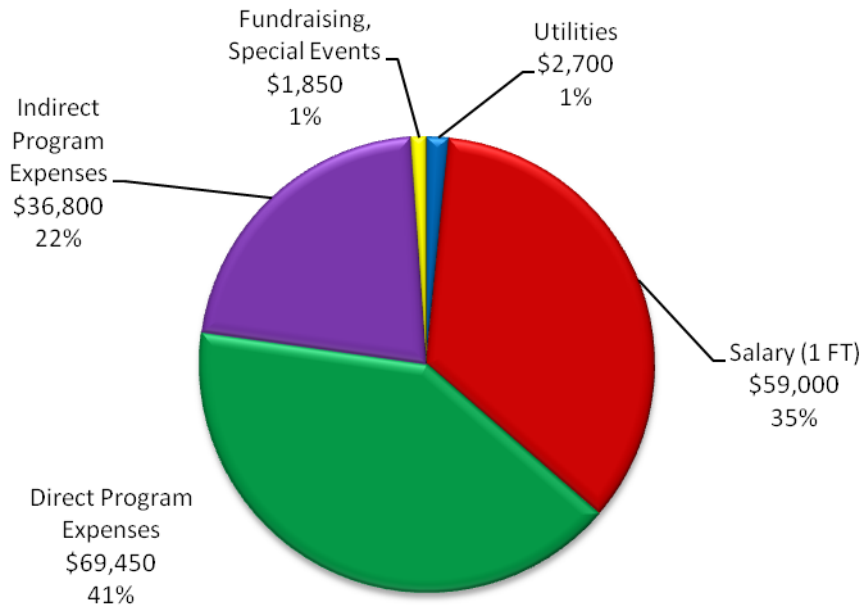
Food bank construction — Ladders, cordless drills, extension cords

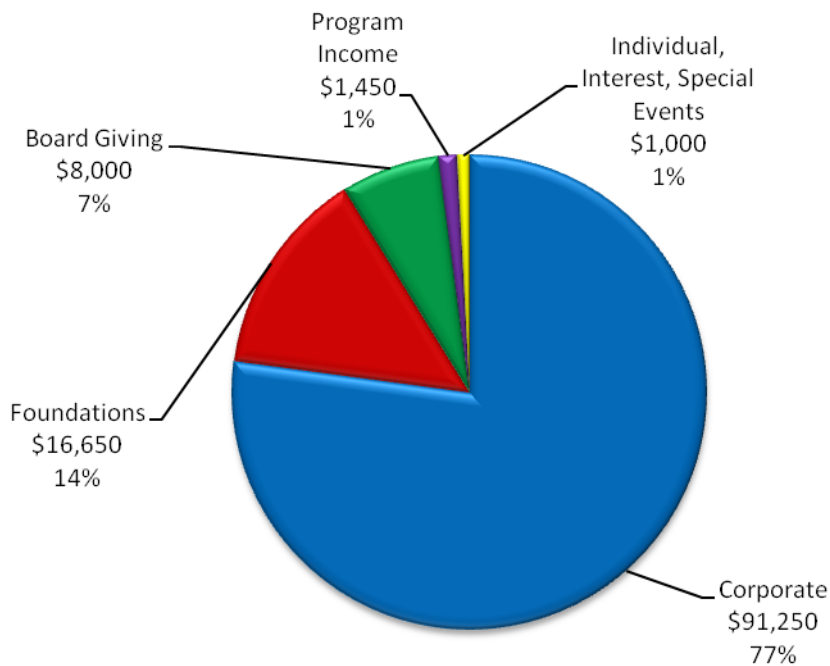
